**010219/6. Spring Festival and Well Dressing - May 19<sup>th</sup> 2019**

**Recommend to Full Council –** follow the same format as 2018, keep five stalls for charities, booked Amber Sound, Ripley Academy of Dance, Face Painter, need to book children's rides, characters, possibly Punch and Judy and ice cream. Rev. Wigram to bless the Well, St John's School making the well dressing and the theme to be to recognise 50 years after "the moon landing".

**010219/7. Pop up Cinema around September 2019**

**Recommend to Full Council –** to research the costs of an outdoor cinema at Greenwich Park (site area TBC) and take on ideas of a popular family film to show.

**010219/8. Big Day Out - July 10<sup>th</sup> 2019**

**Recommend to Full Council –** BDO to be held at Midland Railway may need two engines if weather is good as attendees will be high and avoid queuing for the train, research costs for car park marshalling company to manage parking control, have a similar programme of events as last year, book the play bus, two rides and food van, target pre-school children and carers. Incorporate in the afternoon James Lewis to hold a two-hour valuation session for everyone to bring their items raising funds for a defibrillator for the Midland Railway. Possibly RTC to fund the £750 - £800 cost for the

defibrillator as James Lewis gives his time freely. Church Service taken by Jen Brearley after lunch, research entertainment for the afternoon. Volunteers working and wearing their corporate clothing to be given vouchers for food and drinks. The event to end at 3.00pm.

**010219/9. Youth Provision 2019**

**Recommend to Full Council** – projects to be from late April to mid-September incorporating various items for the youngsters to engage in including learning to play an instrument, hair, make-up, skin care, food, healthy eating and Extreme Wheels and culminating in a concert and skate Jam in September.

**010219/10. Wool Bombing - May 19<sup>th</sup> to June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019**

**Recommend to Full Council** – wool bombing trees to be decorated on the market Place and possibly Crossley Park, AVBC Tree Officer consulted and gives his full support, many groups and schools taking a “trees” to decorate and identified will be launched at the Spring Festival May 19<sup>th</sup> 2019 also ask village schools and associations.

**Recommend to Full Council** – to accept the dates for the bands which will be booked as soon as possible.

**Recommend to Full Council** – format as 2019, children’s rides, Rev. Wigram, Amber Sound and characters all booked. Gifts to be purchased more Christmas stockings and Glow items and arrange Santa and a brass band.

**010219/13. Ripley Family Christmas Market - December 1<sup>st</sup> 2019**

**Recommend to Full Council** – Ferris Wheel, children’s rides, compere, Ripley Dance Academy, Face Painter, characters, choir all booked. Brass band and other entertainment to book. There will be five charity stalls and less food stalls that in 2018.
